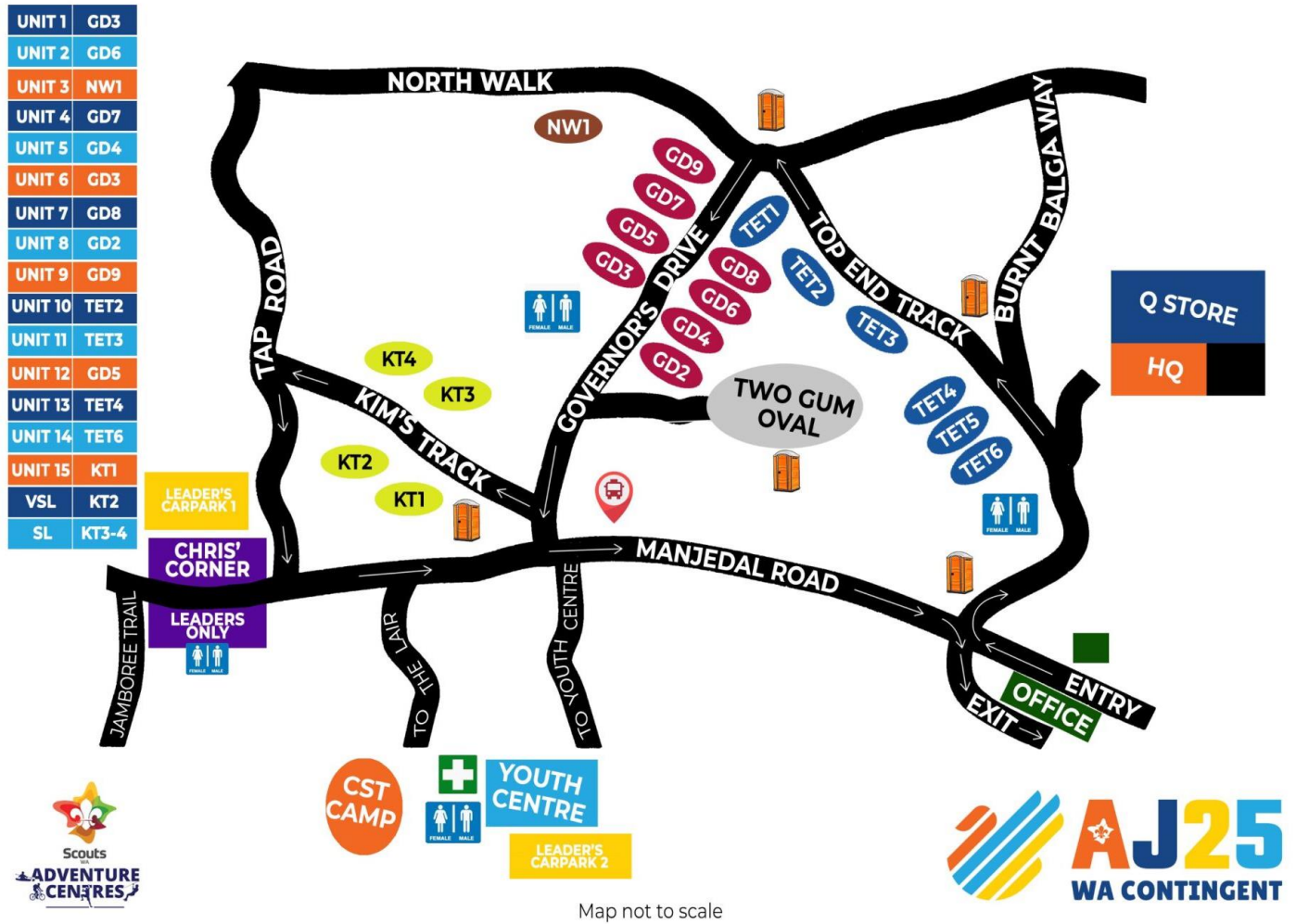

6 Catering

Catering will be provided for all Contingent members at PREJAM. The cost is incorporated into your Jamboree fee. The first meal provided will be lunch on Saturday 21 September 2024 and the last meal provided will be lunch on Monday 23 September 2024.

Jamboree Units will need to cook for all members of their Unit. Food rations will be available for collection from the food distribution point at specified times.

A central kitchen will operate at the Youth Centre dining hall for all Contingent members not part of a Jamboree Unit, including:

- Venturer Scout Service Leaders
- Service and Program Leaders
- Contingent Support Team.

Contingent members eating at the Youth Centre will need to bring their own dilly bag (plate, bowl, cup, cutlery).

6.2 Modified diets

Modified diets will be catered for as nominated by Contingent members in the online Jamboree application system. We are unable to cater for diets not listed in the application system (we can't plan for it if we don't know about it!).

6.3 Food distribution

The food distribution point will be the Q-Store, just near campsite TET6 along Top End Track. Each Unit will need to supply a cart to be able to transport their food supplies back to the campsite. Food distribution from the Q-store will happen at the following times:

- 10:30am-11:00am, Saturday (pantry/initial issue, lunch, afternoon tea)
- 2:30pm-3:30pm, Saturday (dinner, breakfast, morning tea, lunch, afternoon tea)
- 2:30pm-3:30pm, Sunday (dinner, breakfast, morning tea, lunch).

6.4 Ice and gas

Jamboree Units will need to supply their own ice and gas for PREJAM. To assist with replenishment of ice, Units are welcome to use the freezer in the Youth Centre to freeze bottles filled with water. Drink your fruit juice, fill the empty bottle with water and freeze it overnight – then you have replacement ice for your esky!

8 Transport

9 Traffic Management Plan

Given the number of people attending the event, a traffic management plan is necessary to support the safe operation of the event site. The traffic management plan has been broken into three phases as outlined below.

9.1 Phase 1: Participant arrival

9.1.1 Access to campsites along Governor's Drive and Top End Track

1. Enter Manjedal at the front gate
2. Turn right onto Top End Track
3. Drop off Scouts at campsite (TET1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6) or continue if campsite is along Governor's Drive
4. Turn left onto Governor's Drive
5. Drop off Scouts at campsite (GD2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9)
6. Turn left onto Manjedal Drive
7. Turn right onto Gilwell Avenue and exit Manjedal (follow signs to Nettleton Road).

9.1.2 Access to campsites on North Walk

1. Enter Manjedal at the front gate
2. Turn right onto Top End Track
3. Drop off Scouts at intersection of Governor's Drive and North Walk (NW1)
4. Turn left onto Governor's Drive
5. Turn left onto Manjedal Drive
6. Turn right onto Gilwell Avenue and exit Manjedal (follow signs to Nettleton Road).

9.1.3 Access to campsites along Kim's Track

1. Enter Manjedal at the front gate
2. Turn right onto Top End Track
3. Turn left onto Governor's Drive, turn right onto Kim's Track
4. Drop off Scouts at campsite (KT1 or KT2)
5. Continue along Kim's Track
6. Turn left onto Tap Road
7. Turn left onto Manjedal Drive
8. Turn right onto Gilwell Avenue and exit Manjedal (follow signs to Nettleton Road).

9.1.4 Access to parking for attending adults

1. Enter Manjedal at the front gate
2. Turn right onto Top End Track
3. Turn left onto Governor's Drive
4. Turn right onto Kim's Track
5. Turn left onto Tap Road
6. Arrive at parking area
7. If Chris' Corner / Tap Road parking is full, continue to Youth Centre car park via Manjedal Drive.
8. If Youth Centre car park is full, continue to Aganoa Track car park via Manjedal Drive then turn right onto Gilwell Avenue and follow signs to Aganoa Track area.

9.2 Phase 2: Event

All vehicles must be parked safely in the allocated parking areas by 11:00am on Saturday 21 September 2024.

Vehicles must remain in the parking area until 1:00pm on Monday 23 September 2024.

Only vehicles with an approved PREJAM vehicle movement permit will be able to move around Manjedal Adventure Centre during the times nominated above. If adults need to leave Manjedal Adventure Centre during the event, please speak with the Traffic and Security Team at the front gate before moving your vehicle.

9.3 Phase 3: Participant departure

9.3.1 Access to campsites along Governor's Drive and Top End Track

1. Enter Manjedal at the front gate
2. Turn right onto Top End Track
3. Pick up Scouts at campsite (TET1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6)
4. Turn left onto Governor's Drive
5. Pick up Scouts at campsite (GD2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9)
6. Turn left onto Manjedal Drive
7. Turn right onto Gilwell Avenue and exit Manjedal (follow signs to Nettleton Road).

9.3.2 Access to campsites on North Walk

1. Enter Manjedal at the front gate
2. Turn right onto Top End Track
3. Pick up Scouts at intersection of Governor's Drive and North Walk (NW1)
4. Turn left onto Governor's Drive
5. Turn left onto Manjedal Drive
6. Turn right onto Gilwell Avenue and exit Manjedal (follow signs to Nettleton Road).

9.3.3 Access to campsites along Kim's Track

1. Enter Manjedal at the front gate
2. Turn right onto Top End Track
3. Turn left onto Governor's Drive, turn right onto Kim's Track
4. Pick up Scouts at campsite (KT1 or KT2)
5. Continue along Kim's Track
6. Turn left onto Tap Road
7. Turn left onto Manjedal Drive
8. Turn right onto Gilwell Avenue and exit Manjedal (follow signs to Nettleton Road).

9.4 General rules

- All vehicles shall be road worthy under Western Australian State Law
- All vehicles shall be currently registered through a state or federal licencing authority
- All Western Australian traffic rules shall apply
- This includes the wearing of seatbelts whiles vehicles are operational
- This also prohibits riding in the back of an open tray utility or trailer etc
- Speed limits set by any state or federal government authority, or the AJ2025 Contingent Support Team or Manjedal Staff shall be observed at all times
- Speed limit inside Manjedal should not exceed 10 KPH
- All additional road rules set by the AJ2025 Contingent Team should be observed at all times
- Vehicles are not permitted to be moved without a permit at any time between 11:00am Saturday 21 September 2024 and 1:00pm Monday 23 September 2024. If circumstances arise where it becomes necessary to drive vehicles between these times, please speak with the Traffic and Security Team at the front gate before moving your vehicle.
- Moving vehicles shall have the hazard lights switched on at all times.
- Only vehicles with AJ2025 PRECAMP permits will be permitted to move around the site.
- Vehicular movement around Manjedal to be kept to a minimum at all times.
- Vehicles associated with the AJ2025 Contingent Support Team shall be required to obey the above policies and display a vehicle pass.

Any person found to be in breach of any of the above rules, will have their vehicle stopped and depending on severity, the driver may be warned or they may be directed to remove the vehicle from Manjedal and walk. Traffic charges have been preferred against drivers in the past and court convictions obtained for offences committed within the Manjedal site. This will be at the discretion of the AJ2025 Contingent Support Team.

These rules have been established to maintain the safety of all people on the site. **The fact that you have your vehicle on site is a clear understanding that you have accepted these rules and agree to comply with them.**

9.5 Arrival and departure loop

Details regarding the vehicle movement loop that will operate for arrival and departure will be provided in a forthcoming version of this handbook.

9.6 Parking

We anticipate approximately 200 cars will require parking at the event. Parking will be provided at the following locations:

- Youth centre east carpark (general parking)
- Chris corner campground (general parking)
- Tap Road campgrounds (general parking)
- Lair campgrounds (Contingent Support Team parking only)
- Youth centre west carpark (Health & Wellbeing Team parking only).

Overflow parking will be available in the vicinity of Aganoa Track Campsites.

9.7 Trailers

Units will be permitted to unhitch trailers from their vehicle and keep these in the vicinity of their campsite for the duration of the event. All trailers must be positioned so that they do not block roads required for emergency vehicle access. A walk-through will be conducted by the Contingent Support Team on Saturday 21 September 2024 to ensure no trailers are blocking access roads. Trailers that are deemed to be blocking access roads will need to be repositioned to enable emergency vehicles to access the site throughout the event.

10 Accommodation

10.1 Jamboree Units

All Jamboree Units will need to supply sufficient camping equipment to support the effective operation of their Unit for the duration of PREJAM. Metropolitan groups are asked to support regional attendees regarding equipment for this weekend camp.

Jamboree Units (or Scout Groups within a Jamboree Unit) wishing to stay additional nights at Manjedal Adventure Centre (to assist youth members to get additional nights camping for the Jamboree eligibility criteria) can do so by booking directly with Manjedal Adventure Centre as per the standard booking process. Make sure you book the campsite that your Jamboree Unit has been allocated to as per site allocations above (otherwise you'll need to move to your allocated campsite on Saturday morning).

10.2 Program & Service Leaders

Camping for the Program & Service Leaders will be at KT3/KT4. All Program & Service Leaders will need to supply their own tent.

10.3 Venturer Scout Service Leaders

Camping for the Venturer Scout Service Leaders will be at KT2. All Venturer Scout Service Leaders will need to supply their own tent.

10.4 Contingent Support Team

Camping for the Contingent Support Team will be at the Lair Campgrounds. All Contingent Support Team members will need to supply their own tent.

11 Health & Wellbeing

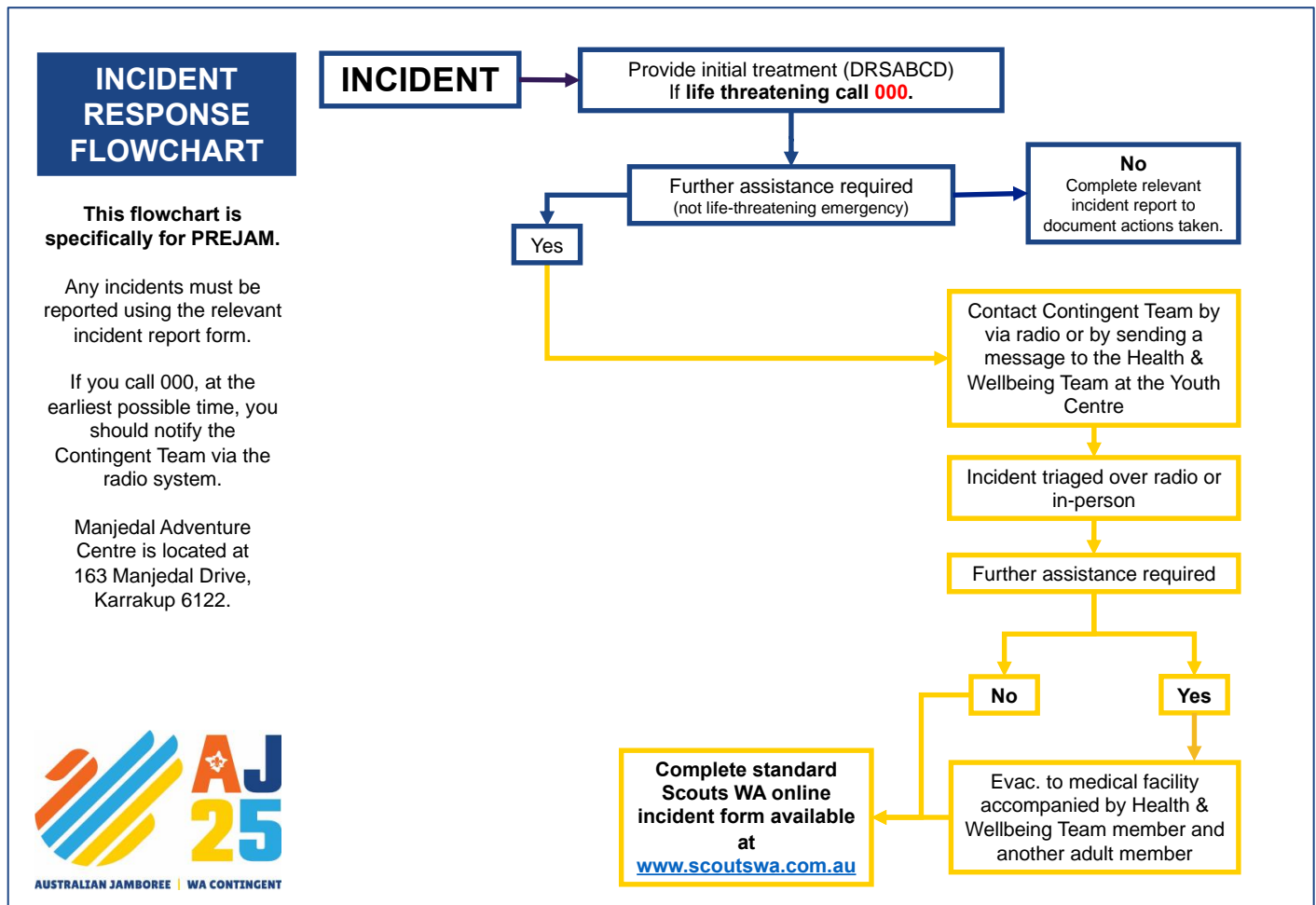
The Health & Wellbeing Team will be located at the Youth Centre.

12 Incident management

Incidents may occur from time to time during the PREJAM event. All incidents should be reported via the appropriate channels.

The standard Scouts WA incident reporting process applies, with the exception that the WA Contingent Team should be notified via the radio system or in-person if further immediate assistance is required.

The flow chart below provides a framework for incident management at PREJAM.



13 Communications

Communications at PREJAM will utilise the existing radio system at Manjedal Adventure Centre.

Two channels will operate:

- Jamboree Units and Contingent Support Officers (MAC Channel 3)
- Contingent Support Team (MAC Channel 4)

Each Jamboree Unit and Contingent Team personnel will be provided with a handheld radio.

The Contingent Support Officers will relay messages between the channels as necessary. Contingent Support Team personnel can switch to the appropriate Jamboree Unit channel should the need arise (e.g., should the Health & Wellbeing Team need to triage an incident).

Jamboree Scout Leaders can obtain charged batteries for their radio at the Q-store during the event, should their battery go flat.
